This is Christ the King Sunday and the end of the Church's liturgical year. The focus of our readings for this great feast is on the Lordship, Kingship of Jesus Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the good thief, Dismas, that he will be in heaven with Him upon his death on his own cross next to Jesus on Calvary. Jesus is the Lord of life and can promise that to whom He sees fit.

St. Paul in the second reading states that, "For in Him were created all things in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible...all things were created through Him and for Him." Given this, God has created us through Jesus, and Jesus having become one of us, born of Mary, will be the one to judge us when we die. As such, He is worthy of the titles Lord and King of all creation. We honor Him at our weekend masses as King and Lord.

Next Sunday will be the first Sunday of Advent as we will begin to celebrate His birth among us at Christmas. It is His birth among us as a man born of Mary, by the power of the Holy Spirit, that makes Jesus the perfect judge of our lives, as He has lived among us and knows our challenges.

This coming Thursday, November 24th, is Thanksgiving Day. There will be mass for this holiday at Ss. Peter and Paul at 9:00AM. Come and give thanks to God for our families and the blessings received in this past year.

Next Saturday, November 26th, is the Christkindlmarkt festival at Ss. Peter and Paul from 12:00 noon till 8:00PM. Come and enjoy old world German culture, food, music and family fun. Stay for the 4:00PM mass, or come for the mass and spend the evening at the festival so you can sleep in the next morning. Bring visitors and friends home for the holiday to this delightful event.

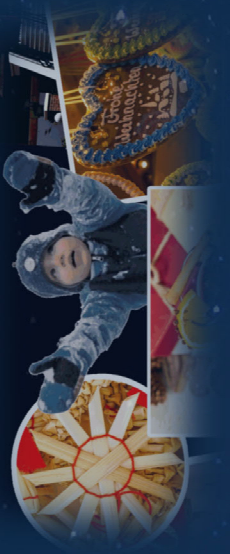
