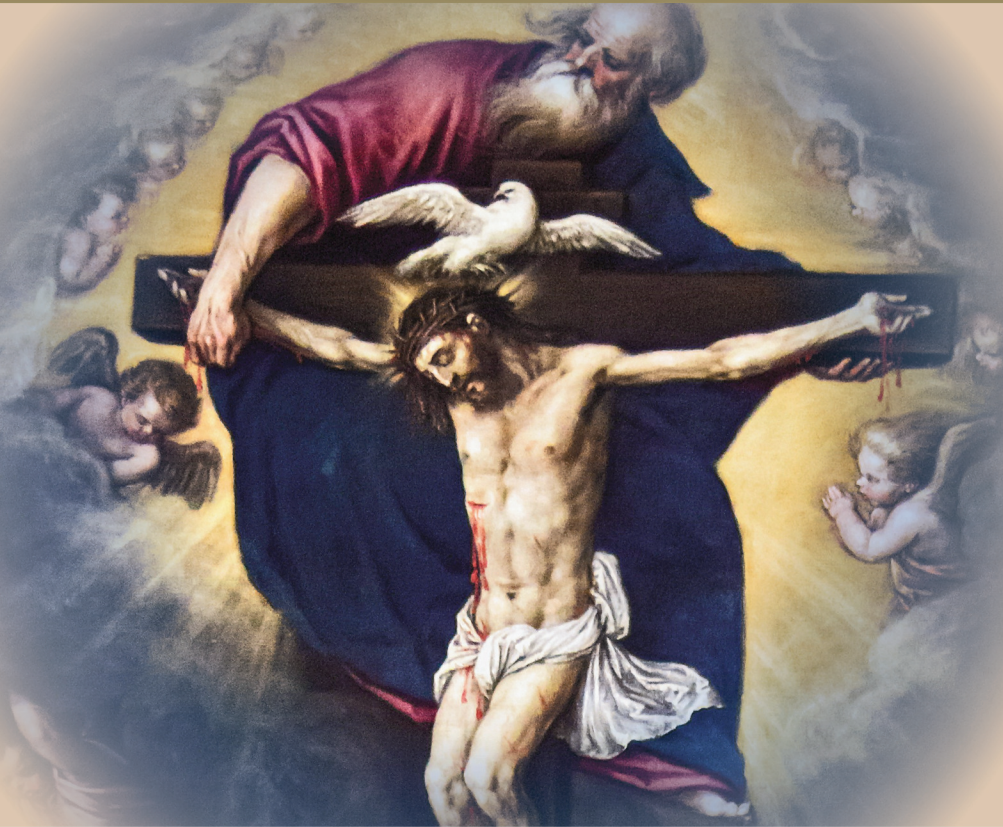

Baptisms:

Make arrangements with the pastor. Copy of Birth Certificate must be submitted, at the latest, one week before the baptism.

Marriages:

Make arrangements with the pastor 6-8 months in advance. Must be a registered parishioner at least six months prior to beginning marriage prep. Cohabiting couples will normally be required to separate before scheduling a wedding.

We will institute first Thursday of each month 3:30-4:00PM confessions. The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus calls for confession on the day before first Fridays. There will not be confessions on the other Thursdays of the month as currently.

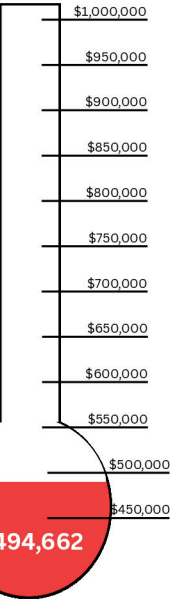

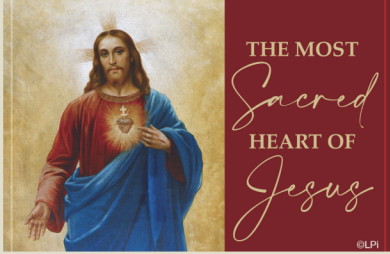

Join the Consecration..

of the United States to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus



PROMISES OF THE SACRED HEART

On May 8, 1873, the devotion to the Sacred Heart was formally approved by Pope Pius IX; and 26 years later – on July 21, 1899 – Pope Leo XIII urgently recommended that all bishops throughout the world observe the feast in their dioceses. **To receive the promises of the Sacred Heart, Jesus asks that we:**

- Receive Holy Communion on nine consecutive First Fridays (with love and reparation).
- Go to Confession regularly (often recommended within 8 days of First Friday).
- Honor and venerate an image of the Sacred Heart in your home.
- Make acts of reparation—prayers, sacrifices, Holy Hours.
- Trust in His mercy and respond with love.

The Promises

- I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
- I will give peace in their families.
- I will console them in all their troubles.
- I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.
- I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.
- Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- Tepid souls shall become fervent.
- Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.
- I will bless those places wherein the image of My Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.
- I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
- Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my Heart.
- In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.

Today, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is celebrated throughout the world on the Friday following the Feast of Corpus Christi.

THE CONSECRATION AND NOVENA

In November 2025, the United States Bishops voted to consecrate the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Thursday, June 11, 2026 - the day before the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This historic decision means the consecration will coincide with America's 250th Anniversary celebration of the signing of the Declaration of Independence.

To prepare spiritually for this consecration, the bishops are inviting the faithful to pray a nine-day novena leading up to that moment. The novena will run June 3-11, ending on the day of consecration. This act is meant to renew the nation in Christ's love and mercy, drawing from the long tradition of devotion to the Sacred Heart. The USCCB frames this as a moment of national spiritual renewal during a major historical milestone.

A HISTORY OF THE SACRED HEART DEVOTION

The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus grew slowly over many centuries, beginning with Christians who loved to meditate on the wounded Heart of Christ—the Heart that poured out love on the Cross.

By the 11th-12th centuries, Christians were already praying about the Five Wounds of Christ, and medieval saints such as St. Anselm and St. Bernard helped deepen reflection on Jesus' Heart as a symbol of His love and mercy.

During the 12th-15th centuries, monastic communities, especially Benedictines and Carthusians, fostered devotion to Jesus' Heart. Saints like St. Gertrude the Great and St. Bonaventure wrote beautifully about *resting spiritually in the Heart of Christ*.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart reached a turning point between 1673-1675, when Jesus appeared to *St. Margaret Mary Alacoque*, a Visitation nun in France. He appeared to her frequently, and in December 1673, He permitted Margaret Mary—as He had once allowed St. Gertrude—to rest her head upon His Heart. As she experienced the comfort of His presence, Jesus told her of His great love and explained that He had chosen her to make His love and goodness known to all.

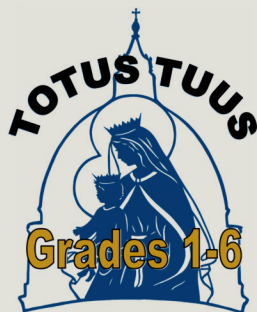
The following year, in June or July of 1674, Margaret Mary reported that Jesus wanted to be honored under the figure of His Heart of flesh. He asked the faithful to **receive Him in the Eucharist frequently, especially on the First Friday of the month, and to observe a Holy Hour of devotion to Him.**

And then in 1675, during the octave of Corpus Christi, Margaret Mary received the vision which came to be known as the "great apparition." Jesus asked that the modern Feast of the Sacred Heart be celebrated each year on the Friday following Corpus Christi, in reparation for the ingratitude of men for the sacrifice which Christ had made for them.

The devotion became popular after St. Margaret Mary's death in 1690. However, because the Church is always careful in approving a private apparition or devotion, the feast was not established as an official feast for all of France until 1765.

DETAILS ON UPCOMING NOVENA TO THE SACRED HEART

The novena draws its daily prayers from the Litany of the Sacred Heart and incorporates reflections from saints, pontiffs, and the teachings of Pope Francis (Dilexit Nos) and Pope Leo XIII (Dilexi Te). Each day offers opportunities for prayer, reflection, and action, framed by the themes of Christ's love, self-giving, and the call to build God's kingdom of love and justice.

The bishops have made the novena a central part of their outreach, inviting parishes, dioceses, and individuals to participate. The goal is to unite the faithful in prayer, reparation, and a deeper relationship with Jesus, so that the consecration can be a moment of renewal and commitment for the nation.

For our part, Ss. Peter & Paul will have booklets for the novena, at the back of church. Again, the novena begins this Wednesday and ends with the consecration of the United States to the Sacred Heart on Thursday, June 11th. Ss. Peter & Paul will conclude this historic event with a vigil Mass for the Feast of the Sacred Heart at 7pm on June 11th. St. Thomas will have Mass on Friday, June 12th, the Feast of the Sacred Heart.

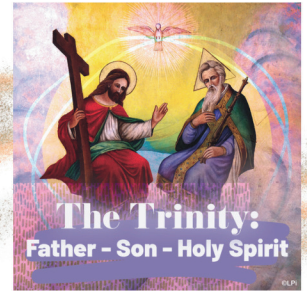
