### Sacrament Guidelines

#### Baptisms:

*Make arrangements with the pastor. Copy of Birth Certificate must be submitted, at the latest, one week before the baptism.*

#### Marriages:

Make arrangements with the pastor 6-8 months in advance. Must be a registered parishioner at least six months prior to beginning marriage prep. Cohabiting couples will normally be required to separate before scheduling a wedding.

This is the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the Easter Season. In our gospel reading Jesus refers to Himself as the shepherd and the gate for the sheep of His flock. It was customary in that part of the world for flocks to be penned together at night for safety from predators. Each shepherd would then come to the gate and call for his sheep, and they would respond to his familiar voice and follow him out through the gate.

Jesus is our good shepherd. As we develop our relationship with Him, it is like becoming able to recognize His voice. We try to grow in our faith and love for Jesus so that we can follow Him in life and not misstep and fall into sin. Jesus is also the gate to eternal life, and we want to follow Him in this life so that we can enter eternal glory through Him when our time comes.

Mary is such a help in growing our faith in Jesus and coming to love Jesus as She does. Reach out to Her for help in coming to love Her Son more and more as She does. May is here next week and is dedicated to Mary. Seek out Her help in May with special attentiveness to be able to love Her Son Jesus more like She does!

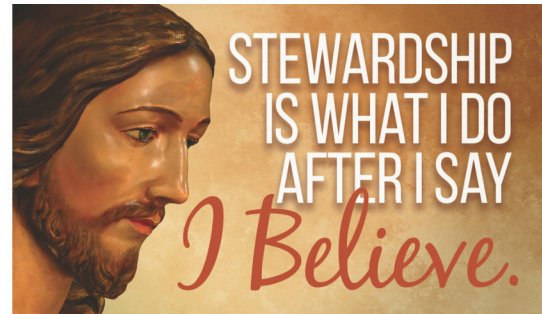

This week we lined the existing sewer. Ouverson Company did the work. They are based nearby.

We also saw cut the basement where the new bathrooms and sewer line will run. This was all done on Monday and finished up on Tuesday of this last week.

May 4<sup>th</sup> will be the day our Contractor will be mobilizing their equipment to start our project. They will be blocking off the entire South side.

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

*"I am the good shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." John 10:11*

My most boring job was working at an insurance company as a college student. My main task? Filing. Now imagine if I had told my supervisor, "I just want you to know, I'm willing to die for these files." She would have called a psychiatrist — or at least security.

There is something absurd in Jesus' words in today's Gospel: **"I am the good shepherd... I lay down my life for the sheep."** (John 10:11) It sounds noble, until you think about it. No one dies for sheep. Not a hired hand. Not even a good shepherd. Sheep are important, sure, but not worth a human life.

And yet, Jesus insists: I will die for them. The crowd understandably responds: **"He is out of his mind."**

C.S. Lewis once said that Jesus does not leave us the option of calling Him merely a good teacher. If someone speaks like Him, he is either lying, crazy, or telling the truth. John's Gospel won't let us stay sentimental. Jesus means it. He reveals a love that surpasses logic — a love that measures worth not by strength or success, but by the willingness to suffer unto death.

The Good Shepherd's madness is mercy. His cross makes no earthly sense and yet it makes divine sense. He lays down His life not for kings or saints but for sheep — for the ordinary, the unworthy, for you and me.

Think of someone who may feel unworthy of love. Do something simple and generous for them, not because they deserve it, but because Jesus did the same for you.

## WHY JESUS IS CALLED "THE GOOD SHEPHERD"

In the hills of ancient Israel, shepherds often built simple sheepfolds out of stones or branches. There was only one narrow opening — no wooden door; no latch, nothing to keep out danger. So the shepherd himself became the door.

At night, after gathering every sheep inside, the shepherd would lie down across the opening. His own body became the threshold. No sheep could wander out without stepping over him. No wolf or thief could enter without facing him first. His presence was the protection. His nearness was the safety. His very life was the gate.

This is the image Jesus chooses when He says, "I am the gate for the sheep... I am the Good Shepherd."

Just as that shepherd placed himself between his flock and every danger, Jesus places Himself between us and anything that would harm our souls. He stands guard over our hearts. He watches through the night. He knows each of us by name. And He lays down His life — not just to protect us, but to lead us into abundant life.

The sheep sleep in peace because their shepherd does not. And we rest in God's love because Christ keeps watch.



**“Whoever enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens it for him, and the sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has driven out all his own, he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice.”** — Jn 10:2-4
