Baptisms:

Make arrangements with the pastor. All classes are offered 4th Thursday of each month. <u>Birth Certificate must be submitted to the</u> <u>office at time of request</u>.

Marriages:

Make arrangements with the pastor 6-8 months in advance. Must be a registered parishioner at least six months prior to beginning marriage prep. Cohabiting couples will normally be required to separate before scheduling a wedding.

First Sunday of Lent



This is the 1st Sunday of Lent. We have begun this holy season of the church year which is intended to be essentially spiritual spring training. One of the sad effects of Original Sin is that it makes entering into and maintaining a close deep relationship with God challenging. As we get busier, or stressed, or focused on something coming up ,we can find it difficult to

turn to God in prayer. If we do pray at such times, it can often become superficial and feel hollow, lifeless.

As we enter Lent, we seek to find a way to join deeply with our Lord and to be able to maintain that closeness even when it would normally be hard to. The parish *Lenten Challenge Book* has a number of ideas for things to do to help to deepen our relationship with Jesus. Fasting from things we like, adding things we don't normally do, are ways which are time tested to produce results. Each time we avoid something, we have decided to give up, is a time to say a short prayer to show the Lord that this is being done for love of Him. Anything that we are adding, such as prayer or volunteering, also provides an occasion for prayer. Lenten practices we may have done before and noticed little or no benefit from long term can acquire greater impact if each time we do them we accompany them with prayer. May this Lent be fruitful for us in the Spirit. May our faith grow and warm us and all whom we meet.

Watch the bulletin for which of our two parishes is hosting Stations of the Cross each week. This is the premier Catholic devotion for Lent in church. Each parish will host it three times. There are also soup suppers and a fish fry during Lent at our two parishes. Details are always available in the bulletin and on our parish websites.


Soup Supper & Stations of the Cross




