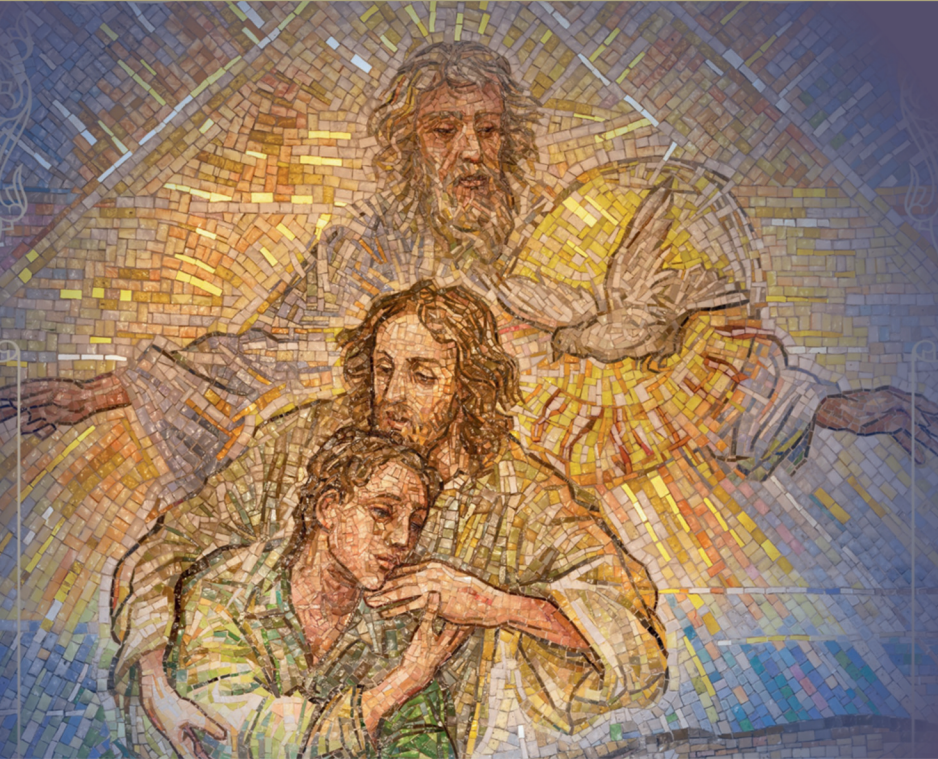

Sacrament Guidelines

Baptisms:

Make arrangements with the pastor. Copy of Birth Certificate must be submitted, at the latest, one week before the baptism.

Marriages:

Make arrangements with the pastor 6-8 months in advance. Must be a registered parishioner at least six months prior to beginning marriage prep. Cohabiting couples will normally be required to separate before scheduling a wedding.

This is the 5th Sunday of the Easter Season. In our gospel reading the apostles Phillip and Thomas question Jesus about Him saying He is going to the Father, and that if you have seen Him, you have seen the Father. This text from St. John's gospel gives us clear teaching about the nature of Jesus as God's son.

Jesus also says that if we believe in Him, we will do the works Jesus does, and greater than Him. If you think of missionaries traveling around the world to spread the good news of the gospel, that would be an example of doing the works of Jesus and even greater than Jesus, as He remained in Israel and empowered His apostles to move beyond it to spread the gospel.

When we share our faith with others, whether in a parish small group meeting, or with a friend or colleague at work, we are doing the work of Jesus. As we move toward Pentecost, let us seek the anointing of the Holy Spirit, we received at our confirmation, to be stirred up so that we may do the work of Jesus with ever greater love and zeal.

I was in Curaçao and went to Mass on 8 March with my cousin at the Cathedral in Willemstad. The Mass was in the local language, Papiamentu. It is known locally as the Cathedral of Pietermaai (Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral), was built in 1875, and consecrated in 1882. It is the seat for the Diocese of Willemstad. It is built in the Dutch colonial style and painted a distinctive golden ochre and white. Inside it features 3 naves and a bronze high altar. A men's choir consisting of a variety of guitars and other traditional instruments played the Sunday we attended and were amazing.

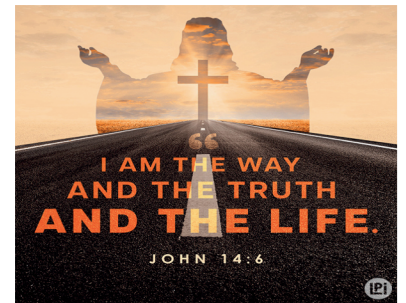
